

**PUBLIC CONDUCT ON SCHOOL PROPERTY
SCHOOL ACTIVITIES**

Alcoholic beverages are not permitted on school property at any time.

Any student in possession of or under the influence of alcohol will be immediately suspended from school for not less than five (5) days. The New Hampshire State Statutes state: "No person shall drink or have in his/her possession any intoxicating beverage while in attendance, as a spectator or otherwise, at any place where a school interscholastic contest is being conducted. Whoever violates the provisions of this section shall be fined not more than fifty dollars or imprisoned for not more than thirty days or both."

The Board encourages the prosecution of any person who commits assault, battery, or assault and battery upon the person of a school employee or student or threatens and places an employee or student of the public schools in immediate fear of bodily harm while the employee or student is in the performance of his/her duties at or for the school.

"School employee" is hereby defined to include any duly appointed person or employee of a firm contracting with a school system for any purpose, including personnel not directly related to the teaching process and including School Board members during School Board meetings.

Loitering on school property is not permitted.

The operation of skateboards and/or of unauthorized motor vehicles: mini-bikes, all terrain vehicles, go-carts, snowmobiles. Permission requests must first be directed to the Principal.
