

Food Service Flash!

Food Service is using a new prepaid register system. The system is called MealMagic and will provide you with new and improved features for managing your child's food service account. Your child will have an account for you to deposit money into for your child to purchase breakfast, lunch, milk or snacks. Check out the highlights below!

- Students will continue with their current student ids. All students must enter the id to start the transaction. No need to learn a new number!
- Payments can be either cash or check. Please be sure to put your child's first and last name with the payment.
- If you have students in multiple schools you may send in one payment to one school and we will credit all accounts as you instruct us.
- Email notifications of low balances will be sent from MealMagic to help you to ensure your child does not have a bill.
- You can customize the account by calling the school cafeteria or writing a note telling us any of the following: no snacks, no charging, no double entrees. This is completely optional.
- An itemized history can be generated showing you what your child had for breakfast or lunch, please contact your school cafeteria to request this report.
- PowerSchool will still have balance information but not transaction history.
- If your child was on the free and reduced meal price program, that information is in the new accounts. Please remember to complete a new application for this school year as soon as possible.
- If your child's account is past due, he/she will continue to receive a regular lunch until it reaches \$10.00. If the past due amount is larger than \$10.00 your child will receive an emergency lunch of a carton of milk and a peanut butter and jelly sandwich.
- Please help us by keeping your child's account positive so that we do not have to provide the emergency lunch to your child.
