COMPETITIONS FOR STUDENTS

The following statements are to guide the administration in deciding if a competition is permitted:

- 1. The primary educational aims of the schools and the needs and interests of the students must be the first consideration at all times.
- 2. Schools shall not be used to promote private interests and causes that have not gained general approval as being for the public welfare.
- 3. The sponsor of the competition must be able and ready to assume all administrative and clerical duties in connection with the competition.
- 4. The competition must be such that students are able to work out contributions by their own efforts.
- 5. The subject must not be commercial, controversial, sectarian, or concerned with propaganda or advertising. It must emphasize high moral standards, good citizenship, and intellectual competence.
- 6. The contest should not place an undue burden on students, teachers or school or require frequent or lengthy absence of participants from school.
