From the Nurse: Free Vision Screening

On **Thursday November 2**nd we will offer **free vision screening** for your child at Bartlett Elementary School. The screening involves a PediaVision SPOT™ Vision Screener that automatically detects common vision problems. Members of the Lions Club will be assisting with the screening.

No physical contact with your child is necessary, and no eye drops will be used. The screening consists of an instant scan (like a photograph) of your child's eyes. You will receive notification of your child's results and if further evaluation is recommended.

The school nurse also screens students for hearing difficulties throughout the school year. This screening involves the use of an audiometer which is designed to determine hearing thresholds levels. Testing headphones will be placed on your child. A variety of tones with various loudness levels will be presented through the headphones. Your child will be asked to press a button when they hear the tone. You will be notified if your child fails their hearing screening at school.

As with any type of vision or hearing screening, a "pass" does not overrule any additional concerns regarding your child's ability to see or hear. A full audiologic or vision evaluation should be done by a specialist if you have concerns about your child's hearing or vision. If you have any questions or you **do not** want your child to participate in vision or hearing screenings, please contact the school nurse before October 16th. 


