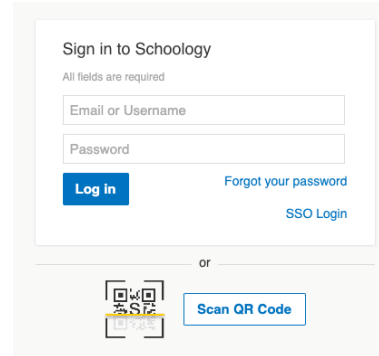

1. Visit [www.schoology.com](http://www.schoology.com) on your internet browser.
2. Click 'Login' and log into your Schoology parent account by using the log in information used when creating your account.



3. Ensure that your name is selected from the profile drop-down menu in the upper right-hand corner. Then click on 'Courses' in the top navigation bar.



4. Click on the 'Parent-Teacher Conference Sign Ups' Course.

**\*Please note enrollments into the Course are manually added once weekly. If you just signed up for your parent account, the Parent-Teacher Conference Course will not be visible until you are added into the Course.**


