Our Parade Route

We will walk north on Maple Avenue and turn around at the intersection of Smith Road (0.3 miles) and return to school (0.6 miles).

Costumes

- Students should consider wearing simple costumes. They must be able to dress themselves including their accessories.
- We encourage children to wear the main pieces of their costume to school.
- Please keep costume weapons, blood and gore at home.

Parking

- Village parking areas may be available.
- There will be one-way only parking along the northern section of Maple Avenue (above Smith Road).
- No parking in the school lots. The school's large and small parking lots will be used as a staging area for our students.

We are asking parents/guardians to follow our current dismissal process and wait until 3:00pm to pick up students.

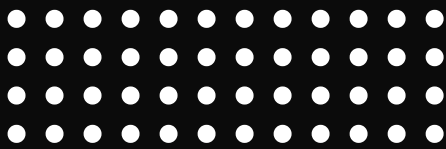
