FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Thanks to generous donations, **financial assistance is available for families in need.** Start the application process as soon as possible as funds are limited. We also accept State of New Hampshire reimbursements. Proof of assistance and a completed child care provider form must be provided at time of registration. Through the Rekindling Curiosity program, qualifying youth can have up to \$750 of their camp fees covered by the Department of Education.

LEADERSHIP CAMPS

Leader In Training (LIT) | Entering 8th – 9th Grade

The Leader In Training program is a blended, two-week camp experience for teens. This opportunity will introduce teens to the Y leadership philosophy, facilitating character development, learning to build and lead activities, as well as give them time to enjoy being a camper. *Teens who register for this program will be asked to complete an application an interview process to demonstrate their readiness and excitement for the program.*

Counselor In Training (CIT) | Entering 10th – 11th Grade

The Counselor In Training program is a four-week camp experience for teens. In camp operations, participants will receive some abridged trainings that camp counselors receive, shadow different camp staff positions, and assist with programming. Additionally, these teens will go through interview training, completing an application, and complete their session with a capstone project. A certificate will be provided at a recognition event at the end of the summer. This is a great opportunity for teens who are seeking a camp job when they are of age. *Teens who register for this program will be asked to complete an application an interview process to demonstrate their readiness and excitement for the program.*

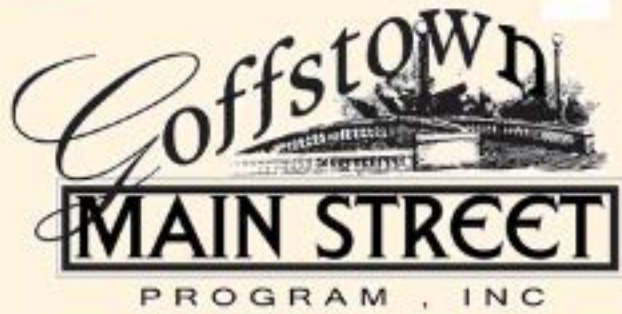
