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# **BUS ROUTES**

Bus routes have been updated for the 2023-24 school year and are available on the SAU 19 website (https://www.goffstown.k12.nh.us/). Choose **Bus Routes** under the **Parents** tab. Please review the appropriate bus run for your child as routes and stops may have changed.

Per town ordinance, between 7:55-8:40 am and 2:15-3:45 pm. only buses are permitted to turn onto Maple Avenue from Elm Street. Additional information was in Cubby's Corner last week and is also available on our school website.

# **DROP OFF AND PICK UP PROCESS**



#### Morning Drop Off Process in Small Driveway

- Families may enter the small driveway starting at 8:10 a.m. Prior to that, staff need to be able to access the school's parking spots.
- Cars must enter the driveway making a left hand turn.
- The driveway is a single lane. Cars enter in a single line and stay in the middle of the driveway.
- Drivers pull up to the furthest cone to let students out. Students should exit the car from the left side (if
  possible) and walk up the sidewalk to the access road and to the playground.
- Drivers should be considerate of others and quickly say their goodbyes.
- Maple Avenue staff will be supervising this area.

\*\*\*Students who arrive after 8:30 a.m. must enter at the main office doors. They are tardy after 8:40 a.m.

#### <u>Afternoon Pick Up Process</u>

- Students may be picked up in the small driveway between 3:00 3:30 p.m.
- Cars must enter the driveway making a left hand turn only.
- Each car must have a sign with the **child's last name, teacher and grade level.**
- The driveway is a single lane. Cars enter in a single line and stay in the middle of the driveway.
- Drivers pull up to the furthest cone and Maple Avenue staff will assist students into the first 5 cars.
- Students are asked to wait in line on the sidewalk until dismissed by a staff member.

#### "On Foot" Traffic

- Parents/guardians wait at the bottom of the driveway near the crosswalk until a staff member releases the child. Parents/guardians should not walk up the line of students.
- Each "on foot" adult must have a sign with the child's last name, teacher and grade level.

\*\*\*For the safety of our students and staff, dogs and other pets are not allowed on school property.

# ANNUAL FORMS TO COMPLETE

To help with a smooth transition back to school, we are asking families to complete our annual student forms **prior to 9/5/23, the first day of school**. This process helps to reduce the amount of paper forms that go home and provides quicker delivery of information to our staff for processing and updating your student's data.

To access your student's forms, log into the PowerSchool Portal at <a href="mailto:sms.saul9.org">sms.saul9.org</a>. Once you have logged in with your credentials, you will navigate to "Forms" in the left menu. Forms are also available in the PowerSchool mobile app under "More" in the menu. We ask that one parent or guardian per student complete the required "Annual" forms listed as "Not Started" to provide our schools with important student and health information, as well as provide the necessary acknowledgements and permissions for the new school year. Any parent/guardian with an access account will see the same set of forms for that student. Your completed forms will have the status of "Pending Review", "Submitted" or "Approved" as staff review and process forms over the upcoming weeks. If possible, please try to upload PDF files instead of phone screen shots due to upload and storage restrictions.
