

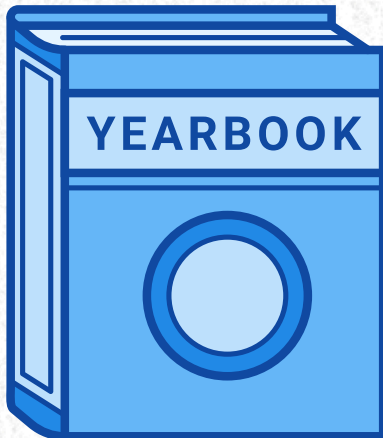

Attention 6th Grade Parents

The State of NH requires all students entering 7th grade to receive the Tdap vaccine (Tetanus and Pertussis) prior to the start of 7th grade. Most children receive this vaccine between ages 10-12. Many current 6th graders are still missing documentation of this vaccine. If your child received this vaccine, we ask that you send in a copy of their immunization record prior to the end of the school year. If your student has not had the Tdap vaccine, please make arrangements with your child's health care provider for him/ her to receive this vaccine before the start of school in September and submit a copy of your student's vaccine record to the MVMS nurses once completed. Feel free to contact the MVMS Health Office with any questions or concerns.

Dear Parents and Guardians,

With the last day of school less than two weeks away, I wanted to take a moment to highlight some of the activities and celebrations that will occur prior to the end of school.

In addition to the 8th Grade Dance and Promotion, we will also be hosting our annual Field Day on Wednesday, June 12th, where all students, in each grade, will be able to engage in a variety of activities and many outdoor backyard games. Please send your student to school with a water bottle, sneakers, sunscreen, and bug spray, as they will be outside for most of the day.

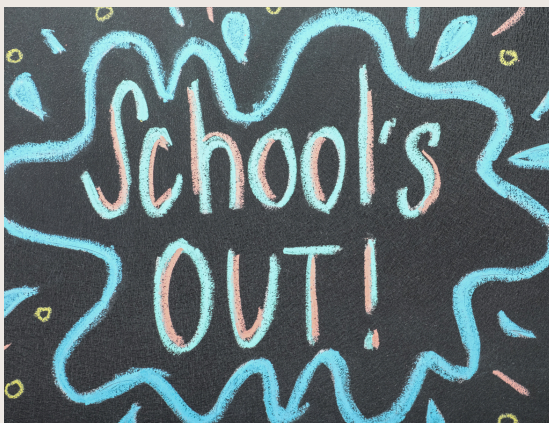

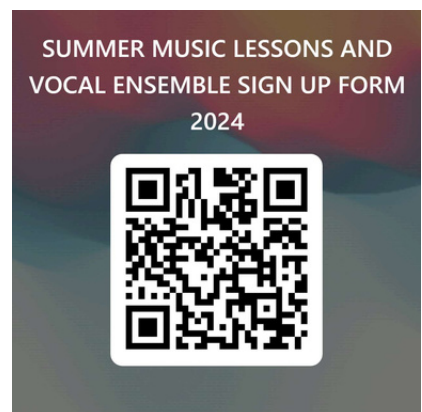
